Program Type A—Anne Arundel County Public Schools
Parents will maintain a portfolio of materials, which demonstrates that regular, thorough instruction is being provided, according to COMAR Regulations 13A 10.10.01C, .01D, and .01E. The portfolio will be reviewed by local school system personnel at least twice during the year, at a mutually agreeable time and place.

Program Type B—Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE)
Program is registered with the MSDE to supervise home schooling. Parent will use correspondence courses under the supervision of registered programs operated by a bonafide church organization or a nonpublic school with a certificate of approval from MSDE.
